#### Curriculum Overview Explorers

There is so much exciting learning in the topic 'Explorers' that it covers the whole summer term! Throughout the topic, we will learn about different explorers and their discoveries. A particular focus will be on Shackleton and his numerous journeys to Antarctica. We will imagine what it was like onboard the Endurance and use this to write our own diary entries. We will also use this term to develop our skills and knowledge needed to be an explorer. Within this, we will learn all about maps- how to read them and even how to draw our own. We will also explore the different plants that explorers may encounter and the environments they need to survive. This topic includes our year 3 sleepover in which Nightingales will have an opportunity to develop their independence and use their explorer skills they have perfected throughout the term! We will have an exciting day with Surrey Outdoor Learning in which the children will take part in woodland skills, team building activities and have a go on a climbing wall.

#### Home Learning

Home learning is set to reinforce skills and knowledge learnt in the classroom and to support children's progress and achievement.

This should include:

- Reading with an adult 5 times each week with a discussion about the story/text.
- Mental Maths: The Mytchett Maths Challenge, which can include DoodleMaths
- Practise statutory spellings (tested termly) 5 words from the year group list and 5 words that follow the spelling rule of that week.
- 1 weekly task from an area of the curriculum.

• A reflection about DoodleMaths learning
