

Curriculum Overview

From Source to Sea: Our first topic this term is all about rivers. The children will begin by studying the processes and features that take place along a rivers course. They will study the importance of water and links to the water cycle. The whole topic will be enriched greatly by a river study during our trip to Runways End.

Groovy Greeks: During the second half term the children will find out where Greece is in the world, what modern day Greece is like and identify where Ancient Greek times link to modern day times. They will learn about Greek Gods, read and act out Greek Myths and write their own versions. The children will compare life in Athens and Sparta and take part in a class debate, before considering what legacy the Greeks left behind. They will finish the topic with a Greek Day.

In this term we will also be looking in detail at a human life cycle, studying physical and emotional changes in puberty and taking part in an art project with specialists around the theme of Space.

- Non-Fiction texts about the Greeks
- Greek myths

- Weekly spelling activity linked to spelling rule – set Friday.

- A reflection about Doodle Maths learning.
- Research about why our upcoming person of the week is significant.
