### **Curriculum Overview**

**Coasts:** During the first half term we will be exploring the topic of coasts and how the coastlines of Britain are formed. In this term, we are going on our residential to Calshot where we will develop our independence and team building skills and make links to our learning and knowledge of coasts to the area we are visiting.

**Lights, Camera, Action!:** This term will be linked to how a play is performed and the history of plays and the theatre. We will look at some of the works of Shakespeare and how plays are created from novels. This term we will be preparing, practising and performing our leavers' play and assemblies.
