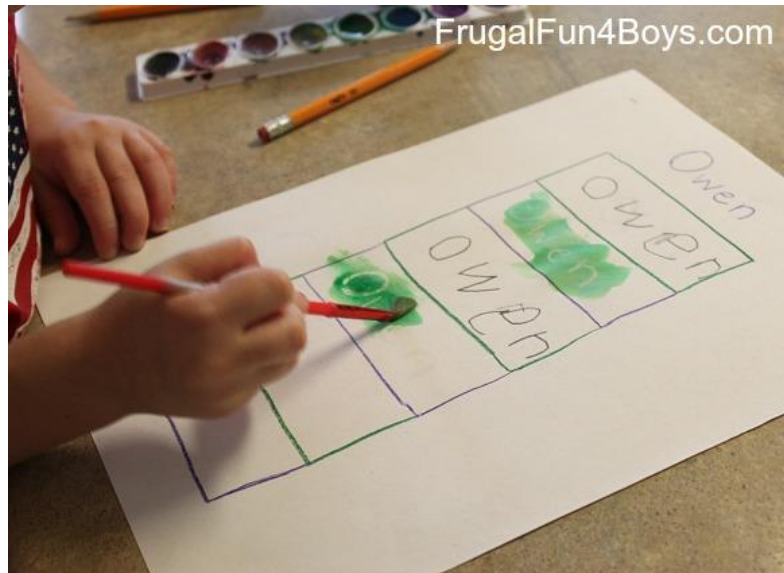

- Straight, tall letters: l, t, i, u, j, k
- 'One-armed robot' letters: r, m, n, b, h, p
