

Jigsaw – Wellbeing Wednesday

This term the children are introduced to the key relationships in their lives. They learn about families and the different roles people can have in a family. They explore the friendships they have and what makes a good friend. They are introduced to simple strategies they can use to mend friendships. The children also learn about Jigsaw's Calm Me and how they can use this when feeling upset or angry.

Aims of these sessions

Children know

- what a family is
- that different people in a family have different responsibilities (jobs)
- some of the characteristics of healthy and safe friendships
- that friends sometimes fall out
- some ways to mend a friendship
- that unkind words can never be taken back and they can hurt
- how to use Jigsaw's Calm Me to help when feeling angry
- some reasons why others get angry

Social and Emotional Skills

Children can

- suggest ways to make a friend or help someone who is lonely
- use different ways to mend a friendship
- recognise what being angry feels like
- use Calm Me techniques when angry or upset

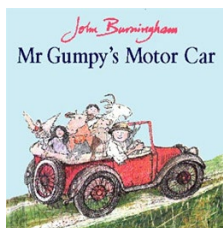


A remake of Baa Baa Black sheep but with a transport twist! We are sure you will be hearing this at home!

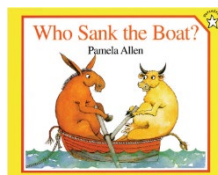
Wow! 80 different modes of transport. A great book to start our learning journey.



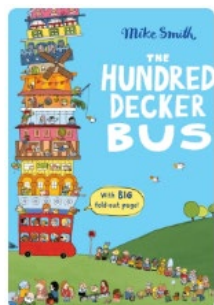
We meet King Charles III on his colourful Coronation day. A chance to revisit our learning about colours. What can we remember?
