







Ladybirds – Life cycle


Celebrating the Coronation of King Charles III

## Reading

This half term we will begin to read longer sentences with harder to read and spell words. We will also begin reding longer words with all previously taught digraphs and trigraphs.

Words we will be reading by sight are: said, so, have, were, out, like, some, come, there, little, one, do, children, love

### Writing

We will continue to write words which are spelt phonetically by applying our phonic knowledge. We will be writing simple labels, captions and sentences more independently.

#### **Maths**

We will deepen our understanding of numbers 1-10 and how to make these numbers in different ways. We will begin to add and subtract using number sentences.

We will learn to confidently recall number bonds to 5.
