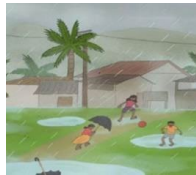

Facts about India



Chembakolli is a small village in the South of India.

Chembakolli has a warm and wet climate. This part of India experiences monsoons.



The people who live in Chembakolli are called the Adivasi or tribal people.

Houses in Chembakolli are built using small wooden materials and sticks. The walls are plastered with mud.



The children go to school in a town called Gudular.

Population	The population of a country or area is all the people who live in it.
Settlement	A community of people such as a village, a town or a city.
Plantation	An area of land where crops are grown.
Tribe	A group of people who live together and share beliefs.
Adivasi	The tribal people who live and work in the Nilgiri Hills.
Weather	The conditions outside at a particular place or time.
Climate	The long- term pattern of weather in a given area.
Monsoon	A strong wind that brings lots of rain.
