Frequently asked questions

Does In2Care Provide a food for my child?

A healthy and nutritious Afternoon Snack will be provided when your child arrives at the club and drinking water, milk and squash will always be available. The After School club snack is a substantial snack, and not a 'tea'. Please note we are a Nut-Free site.

What can my child do at a session?

Our sessions all about having time to unwind, relax, and have fun! Our approach to our Clubs is all about Children's choice and being a Child-led provision. A typical session will include a substantial and yummy Snack Time, to refuel after a day at school. There are opportunities to catch up with friends (or make new ones!), play board games, complete puzzles, get involved with construction play, drawing, reading, arts & crafts and outdoor play, games and challenges! Alongside this, we always have adult-led activities on offer too, such as team games and daily arts and crafts activity.

How will my child get to the After School Club?

The School Office will receive our daily registers at 2.30pm and will notify the Class Teachers of who is in attendance of After School Club on that day.

How will I collect my child from the After School Club?

We have a 4.15pm or a 6.00pm collection time. Our site number is on the school gate. Simply save our site number and call us letting us know who you are collecting.











What happens if someone else needs to pick up my child?

Only contacts listed as a Collector on your account can pick up your child. You can easily amend this by logging into your account. Any person collecting your child must be over 16 years of age.

What if I am late collecting my child?

We ask that you aim to collect a few minutes before the session finish time to allow for a handover at the gate. If you are late, our late fees are £10 per 10 minutes, per child.

My child is going to be absent, or I need to cancel a session, what should I do?

You can cancel your sessions through the booking system. Please note we require 48 hours' notice for changes to sessions, or to receive credit on your account.

Is there a booking deadline for After School Club sessions?

You can book online up until the session start time. If you book after 2.30pm, you will need to call the school office to advise the school

Does my child need to bring anything with them?

Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather—for example, a waterproof coat during winter and a sun hat with sun cream during the summer months. All personal items brought to the club should be clearly labelled. We kindly ask that children do not bring any valuable toys or belongings, as we cannot take responsibility for lost or damaged items.

Who will be working with my Child(ren) at After School Club sessions?

All staff employed with In2Care undergo a fully enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check and are registered with the DBS Update Service. Our team receives comprehensive training through our Induction Programme, which includes Safeguarding and Child Protection, Activity and Session Delivery, Food Hygiene, Behaviour Management, and Health & Safety. Each session will always have at least one qualified Paediatric First Aider present.

I'm worried about how reliable this service is, will you ever cancel?

We will <u>never</u> cancel a session. Even during tricky times with Covid/Isolation times in the past, we have never cancelled a session. We are the most reliable Childcare service a school will ever work with, and we are very confident saying this!
