Adults in School

- Teach you how to recognise risks and how to protect yourselves and keep yourselves safe.
- Make sure you know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.
- Make sure that all the adults in school are people that you can trust.
- Look after you, listen to your worries and help you solve your problems.

Children

To keep yourself safe, the children at Mytchett Primary School will:

- Talk to a trusted adult in school if you need to.
- Be alert to risks in different situations and know how to protect yourselves and keep yourselves safe.
- Think carefully about the choices you make.
- Quickly and safely follow rules that you are given by adults.



Parents

To keep you safe, the parents of children at Mytchett Primary School will:

- Make your homes a safe place.
- Work with the school to keep you safe.
- Make sure that the school can contact them at anytime
- Help you to recognise risks and know how to protect yourself and keep yourselves safe.
- Guide you to play safely and appropriately for your age; this includes game ratings and social media age restrictions.
- Help you to understand the consequences of your choices.
